2010 PROGRAM

Dear Parents:

We are planning an **8-Week Summer Program** from **June 21 to August 13, 2010**. Each session will be 4 weeks. Before and after school care is also available for the students. Class time involves regular and more relaxed work using the traditional Montessori materials with adherence to Spring Valley School's established Montessori Philosophy.

We will use the school's lovely outdoor environment extensively for nature studies, field observation, gardening and recreation. Summer is an excellent season to observe plant and animal life on the school's nature trails around the pond and through the woods located on 14 acres. Also, sports and games, arts and crafts and creative writing are on our agenda.

Preschool will work with Practical Life, Sensorial, Language and Math. They are planning to focus on plants and animals in the ocean with a visitor coming to the class to talk and show the life cycle of a clown fish. The students will also enjoy arts, crafts and cooking.

Preprimary will have daily work of math, language and reading. The class will also learn about the Pacific West Coast Native Americans and study a variety of art and craft projects related to this subject. They will include music and focus on fun related projects.

Elementary plan to explore the biodiversity and wonder of Earth's oceans. They will compare the tropical reef biome and the temperate rocky shores. Students will also research ocean animals. The class plans to visit the Redondo Beach Research Center and attend the Seattle Storm Women's Basketball Kid's Day at Key Arena. Subjects: language, math, art and reading will be part of the daily routine. The elementary students will enjoy cooking their own lunches on Wednesday and have weekly excursions on Thursdays to Pattisons West Skating Rink.

If you wish to enroll your child for the Summer School Program, **please fill out the attached form and return to the Main Office**. We are looking forward to an exciting and colorful summer.

Students may attend the **Summer Program either half day or full day**. For **vacation time** of one week or more, tuition may be pro-rated. Before and after school care is also provided to Spring Valley students during summer and may be requested on a daily or weekly basis with at least two days prior notice from parents.
